1439. Christmas Trees

The Clerk reported that ANSA had not replied yet but that trees are 30% of the cost (2018: £355 each, total of £1,065 for trees, £2,487.28 for dressing, power, etc prices ex VAT). Given the cost of planting, establishing and maintaining mature trees, it was not considered cost effective to plant trees. Cllr Meakin proposed, Cllr C Harwood seconded and it was RESOLVED to carry on providing Christmas trees as the Council currently does. It was also agreed that PEEP will look at planting up the Station Road/Congleton Road North triangle.

1440. General Data Protection Regulation & Data Protection Act Cllr R Griffiths proposed, Cllr Shaw seconded and it was RESOLVED with 9 for and 1 against to adopt a policy on third

party data sharing.

1441. Reports & Updates

A) Report from committees & working groups – Reports were received from Planning, Community Transport, Newsletter and the Neighbourhood Development Plan.

B) PCSO – a written report had been received.

C) CEC Report – Cllr Wardlaw reported on CEC matters including the ongoing review of the arms length service delivery vehicles and speed reduction on A34.

Cllr C Harwood reported that the gulley in Sandbach Road had been repaired.

Cllr Clowes reported on Rhoda's farewell event.
