A) Report from committees & working groups – Planning, reported on enforcement and applications (applications previously circulated to members): Grants, Cllr R Griffiths proposed, Cllr Lawton seconded and it was unanimously RESOLVED to adopt the recommendations of the Grants Committee (including the grants agreed in 1555 and moving the APM from to the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday in May); Community Transport, the service will be suspended during the Covid 19 pandemic; Christmas Tree Working Group, progress noted.

B) PCSO Report – No report was received.

C) Cheshire East matters – There were no CEC Councillors present.

D) Village halls – The Council's representatives reported that the halls were closed due to the Covid 19 pandemic.

#### 1558. <u>Covid 19 Pandemic</u>

There was a thorough discussion about the pandemic and the impact on the Council's decision making process.

Cllr Shaw proposed, Cllr R Griffiths seconded and it was unanimously RESOLVED that, subject to the Government's guidelines and any legislative changes, the Council shall suspend all meetings and hold the four statutory full Council meetings later in the year. All powers of the Council that it can delegate be delegated to the Clerk for the duration of the pandemic. The Clerk will liaise with the Chairman before exercising powers and will liaise with councillors before making comments on planning applications. Financial Regulations and Standing Orders be suspended in so far as they cannot be adhered to in the situation (all receipts and payments to be reported to councillors on a regular basis). Should the Clerk be unable to exercise the delegated powers for whatever reason, e.g. illness, the powers are delegated to an Emergency Committee which shall comprise Cllr Clowes, Cllr Lawton, Cllr B Griffith, Cllr R Griffiths, Cllr Shaw and Cllr Meakin.
