Police & Community Support officer – There was no report.

Cheshire East Matters – Cllr Redstone reported on CEC matters including Highways (budget for fully repairing 16 miles of road in CEC); Winter gritting proposals not adequate; £12,000 in budget for changing stiles to disable friendly gates on PROW; and the proposed burial site/crematorium by the Horseshoe Public House.

Cllr C Harwood raised the issue of road closures and police presence for Remembrance Sunday.

Village Halls – Brief reports were given: Scholar Green (Summer Produce Show cancelled); Mount Pleasant (looking at a number of projects including a defibrillator, could the Council help?); Rode Heath (events programme being agreed); YPCC (meeting next day).
